Prescription Savings with your Co-op Connections Card



Would you like to pay less for your next prescription at your local pharmacy? If so, join the hundreds of SSVEC members who are using their Co-op Connections Cards and receiving a discount on their prescription drugs.

In all, SSVEC members have saved more than \$18,900 on 961 prescriptions since January!

This is not an insurance; it is simply a discount.

That means there's no paperwork to complete. All you have to do is show your card at the pharmacy when you pick up your prescription.

Information on-line

The Co-op Connections Card is accepted at more than 60,000 retail pharmacies nationwide, including CVS, Walgreens, Walmart, Target and more.

You can find participating pharmacy locations at www.locateproviders.com. (The group and member numbers requested at this site are found on the back of your card.)

And you can check the discounted price of a prescription on-line.

If you know the name, strength and quantity of the medication, visit www.rxpricequotes.com.

Questions about the Pharmacy Discount

Can I use my Co-op Connections Card with my current insurance benefit to reduce my costs?

Your card **cannot** be used in conjunction with insurance. However, you can use your card to purchase prescriptions not covered by your insurance plans at a discounted rate.

Will I always receive the lowest price?

Yes. You will receive the best price available to you through this program at the pharmacy.

On occasion, pharmacies will price a particular medication lower than the discount rate provided by the card.

If that occurs, you will receive the lower price.

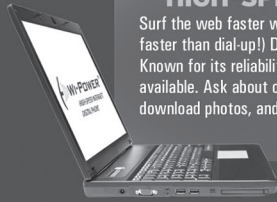
